Julie Boserup

In the exhibition **Transformer**, the Danish artist Julie Boserup combines collage and photography in an expanded field, deconstructing and transforming space and architecture.

Using collage as her artistic basis, Julie Boserup creates complex, multi-dimensional spaces. All the works in her solo show, previously shown at Viborg Kunsthall, tackle transformation as a process, in which familiar shapes are transformed into new ones.

Julie Boserup has formulated her own unique practice, which hovers somewhere between photography,

collage, drawing and archive-based research.

With her keen eye for the peripheral, marginalised, abandoned and hidden elements of our world, she juxtaposes ancient caryatids, threadbare carpets, deconstructed architectural photographs and broken wooden mouldings in new, two- and three-dimensional collages, in which the whole is always greater than the sum of the parts.

In **Transformer**, Julie Boserup challenges the way we see and experience spaces and architecture. The exhibition is presented on two floors of the White Mansion.
